One of the national spread and adoption programmes agreed by the AHSN Network for delivery in 2018/19 to 2019/20 is **Medicines Optimisation**, which consists of three key projects: Polypharmacy, prescribing safety in primary care (PINCER) and Transfers of Care around Medicine (TCAM).

We are seeking to recruit/second [an experienced Programme Manager](#) to work with Wessex Academic Health Science Network on this exciting national programme.

The work will include:

- Establishing and supporting the MO National Programme Board
- Providing support to all AHSNs who will be implementing one or more of the three MO projects in their regions
- Arranging regular webinars, teleconferences and face to face meetings to bring together project managers and clinical leads from across all 15 AHSNs to provide detailed, practical support around implementation
- Producing & sharing implementation tools and guidance
- Co-ordinating metrics reports
 - Working with the national AHSN Metrics Group
 - For reporting to the Delivery Oversight Group
- Providing ad hoc reports to DOG and chief officers as required
- Capturing and sharing learning about models of spread and adoption nationally, supporting evaluation of the national roll-out
